Always tests too high: Repeated test results indicating that the pH in your pool water is high indicates a high total alkalinity. Add a pH decreaser to balance the total alkalinity.

If pool water stains the surface of your pool, you can test for metals such as copper or iron using special test strips designed for the purpose. Chloramines (combined chlorine) can be tested with a DPD test kit. ShockCheck test strips can tell you when shocking is needed to remove chloramine.

How to Use a Pool Test Kit to Check Water Quality

Operator must test the water for CI and pH every hour, and Total Alkalinity, Calcium Hardness and Cyanuric Acid once per week. Records must be maintained on site and available for at least 2 years at the pool and 3 years total.

The pH level represents the total acidity of pool water. It's measured on a scale of 1 to 14: 1 through 6 indicate how much acidity; 8 through 14 indicate alkalinity. Right in the middle—7.3 to 7.7 ppm—is neutral, and where pool water should be. If the pH level is too low, water can irritate swimmers' eyes and skin.
