According to the Boston & Maine Historical Society its peak workforce included roughly 28,000 individuals. The railroad operated major yards in Boston, East Deerfield, Rigby, and Mechanicville while its primary maintenance facilities were located at North Billerica, Massachusetts and Concord, New Hampshire.

New Boston Railroad - New Boston Historical Society

The Boston and Maine Railroad was chartered in New Hampshire on June 27, 1835, and the Maine, New Hampshire and Massachusetts Railroad was incorporated March 12, 1839, in Maine, both companies continuing the proposed line to South Berwick, Maine. The railroad opened in 1840 to Exeter, New Hampshire, and on January 1, 1842, the two companies merged with the Boston and Portland to form a new Boston and Maine Railroad.

In 1842, all the railroad companies that made up the Massachusetts to Maine route merged, carrying forward the Boston & Maine Railroad name. With construction of new rail lines and the lease and acquisition of other railroad companies, by 1900 the B&M had a dense ...
