In the APA (American Psychological Association) format, one of several documentation formats, you briefly identify your sources in the text of your paper, then give the full information in the Reference List at the end of the paper.

General APA Guidelines Your essay should be typed and double-spaced on standard-sized paper (8.5" x 11"), with 1" margins on all sides. Include a page header (also known as the " running head ") at the top of every page. For a professional paper, this includes your paper title and the page number.

In-text citation is usually written in a parenthesis with the last name of the author and year separated by a comma. If the last name of the author is included in the text, write only the year inside the parenthesis. Include the name of the author, year, and page number if a part of a work is directly quoted.

Helpful Tips: Treat a government document as a book, report, or brochure. If a person is named on the title page, use her or him as author. If no person is named, use the government agency, department, or branch as a group author. Give the name of the group author exactly as it appears on the title ...
