The Quality of Life Scale (QOLS) originated from John Flanagan, who was an American psychologist (Burckhardt & Anderson, 2003). The Quality of Life Scale measures things like satisfaction, perceptions of control, involvement, commitment, and work-life balance, in terms of one's personal perception.

Overview. The WHOQOL is a quality of life assessment developed by the WHOQOL Group with fifteen international field centres, simultaneously, in an attempt to develop a quality of life assessment that would be applicable cross-culturally.

Adaptations have been developed for people with HIV (WHOQOL-HIV) and an additional 32 item instrument has been developed to assess aspects of Spirituality, Religiousness and Personal Beliefs (WHOQOL-SRPB).
